i What? The Sagrada Familia basilica, which reached its highest point with the completion of its central tower, officially becoming structurally complete after more than 140 years of construction.

u Who? The architects and workers responsible for the construction of the Sagrada Familia, the famous basilica designed by Antoni Gaudí in Barcelona.

g Where? In Barcelona, the second largest city in Spain.

📅 When? In February 2026, after construction began in 1882.


? Why is it important? Because the Sagrada Familia is one of the most famous monuments in the world. Its completion marks the end of an exceptional architectural project that began in the 19th century and was interrupted several times.

🎯 For this activity, your goal will be to learn more about the Sagrada Familia basilica.

- Discover the history of the basilica's construction.
- Locate Barcelona and the Sagrada Familia in Europe.
- Organize historical events on a timeline.
- Write a short informative text based on the information gathered.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

STEP 1 — Finally Finished? Watching of a short report on the installation of the cross atop the central tower and answers to four comprehension questions.

Q1 — 55 feet high.

Q2 — The tower of Jesus-Christ

Q3 — 144 years

Q4 — Glass and ceramic

STEP 2 — To Make a Long Story Short... Creation of a timeline of the Sagrada Familia's history. Information taken from the Sagrada Familia website.

Q1 — The basilica construction project is launched.

Q2 — Antoni Gaudí takes over the project.

Q3 — Antoni Gaudí dies after being struck by a tram.

Q4 — The cross is installed at the top of the Passion façade.

Q5 — The cross is installed on the central tower of Jesus Christ.


STEP 3 — A Historical Event to Cover! Write a short, informative article about the information gathered during the activity.

What is the difference in height between the Sagrada Familia and Rouen Cathedral?
Sagrada Familia: 172.5 m. Rouen Cathedral: 151.0 m. Calculation: $172.5 - 151.0 = 21.5$ meters

What is the average height of these five churches? $800.2 \div 5 = 160.04$ m

What natural forms inspired Gaudí?

- Trees/branches → branching columns
- Mountains/peaks → pointed towers
- Fruit → colorful decorations on the tops of the towers
- Seashell/spiral → spiral staircases






The Sagrada Familia at the Top! (February 26, 2026)



With the addition of the cross on the tower of Jesus Christ, the Sagrada Familia became **the tallest church on Earth**, with a height of **172.5 meters!**
